

CONFLICT MINERALS STATEMENT

Conflict Minerals are defined in 2010 United States legislation, Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act, Section 1502(e)(4) as columbite-tantalite (coltan), cassiterite, gold, wolframite, or their derivatives, or any other mineral or its derivatives determined to be financing conflict in the Democratic Republic of the Congo or an adjoining country. 3TG is defined as Tantalum, Tin, Tungsten, and Gold. US and EU Regulations have been established pertaining to the responsible sourcing of minerals.

BioSpectra does not intentionally add or use any conflict minerals or 3TG in the manufacturing process of Tris Hydrochloride, Bio Excipient Grade, and Bio Pharma Grade. Metal catalysts or metal reagents are not used by BioSpectra in the manufacture of Tris Hydrochloride, Bio Excipient Grade, and Bio Pharma Grade.
